Day One

Arrive at Nashville International Airport and board your private coach for transfer to your downtown Nashville hotel to check in, and have some free time to relax and settle in and have dinner on your own.

Haunted Downtown Nashville Walking Tour - Explore the shadow-filled streets of downtown Nashville as you learn about the historical, haunted heritage of Music City from professional story tellers during this 90-minute walking tour. Your lantern-bearing tour guide, dressed in historic costume, will lead you through the dark mysteries and supernatural experiences of some of Nashville's most recognizable landmarks such as Ryman Auditorium, Tennessee State Capitol, President Polk's Tomb, and Printer's Alley.

Day Two

Visit the Country Music Hall of Fame and Museum – This has been the home of Country Music since 1967. Get up close with the iconic instruments, lyrics, and fringe-tastic fashion that has shaped country music to date. A treasure trove of historic country video clips and recorded music, dynamic exhibits and state-of-the-art design, a regular menu of live performances and public programs, a museum store, live satellite radio broadcasts, on-site dining, and fabulous public spaces all contribute to an unforgettable Museum experience.

Visit Walk of Fame Park – Time to explore the park that is home to the Music City Walk of Fame featuring in-laid granite stars honoring legendary figures in the music industry.

Day Three

Guided Bus Tour of Nashville with Professional Guide - Tour highlights include The Parthenon, Music Row, Tennessee State Capitol Building, Bicentennial Capitol Mall State Park and Nashville Farmers Market.

Grand Ole Opry with guided backstage tour - There's nothing like a backstage tour of the Grand Ole Opry House - it's a must-see for everyone in Music City! Walk in the footsteps of country music's superstars and get an exclusive look at what happens behind the scenes of the show that made country music famous! Your knowledgeable guide will share stories about the Opry and country music greats, past and present (from Minnie Pearl to Carrie Underwood, you might say), show you photos from the Opry's biggest moments in history and take you to the artist entrance - where legends, new artists, and superstars alike enter the Opry House on the night of an Opry show. You may

even have the chance to step on stage and into the famed wooden circle as decades of artists have done.

Day Four

Andrew Jackson Hermitage House & Museum - The Hermitage, Home of President Andrew Jackson, is one of the largest and most visited presidential homes in the United States, and recently named the #1 historic house in Tennessee. During the tour you will visit the family mansion, the formal garden, slave quarters and the original log cabin. Witness "The Duel: The Art of the Southern Gentleman." This 30-minute visitor experience will answer questions about dueling followed by an ACTUAL demonstration by our historic re-enactors. "

Performance at Andrew Jackson Hermitage House & Museum

Belle Meade Plantation with guided tour - The land known today as Belle Meade, has stood witness to centuries of human history. Native tribes used the woodlands and meadows as a place to hunt wild game. Over time a trail developed through the land that was eventually known as the old Natchez road by European settlers. Ancient tribes had used the trail as a trade route throughout the Southeast and newly arrived settlers did the same in the 18th and 19th centuries. **Additional Performance Opportunity available**.
